In 2009, assassins tracked her to her home and stabbed her seven times in the face and chest. Since the attack, Julia has undergone eight facial reconstructive surgeries, and continues to live in hiding. DANNY, who at eighteen joined a right-wing paramilitary's enormous training camp in the Eastern Plains of Colombia. Initially lured by the promise of quick money, Danny soon realized his mistake and escaped to Ecuador. He describes his harrowing escape and his struggle to survive as a refugee with two young children to support. Ashley is on the path she's meant to be on. She chose it, she's got to stick with it right? But when faced with temptation and haunted by unrealised dreams, she starts to wonder if fate has other plans. Everything she wants could be just around the corner - unless she screws it up completely, first. How can she follow her heart, if she's not even sure what her heart wants?
