Status, Power and Ritual Interaction identifies status and power as the twin forces that structure social relations, determine emotions and link individuals to the reference groups that deliver culture and administer preferences, actions, beliefs and ideas. An especially important contention is that allegiance to ideas, even those as fundamental as the belief that $1 + 1 = 2$, is primarily faithfulness to the reference groups that foster the ideas and not to the ideas themselves.
