However, Jaguar stuck with the car and the result is a twenty-one year production history and a firm place in the classic jaguar list.

It survived the British Leyland days, Jaguar's privatization and the takeover by Ford, and is now much in demand as an affordable and practical classic car. It took several years for the XJ-S to be accepted as a car in its own right rather than as a replacement for the E-type. It is an uncompromising 2+2 with distinctive styling. During the late eighties and early nineties, both styling and mechanical upgrades, made the car even more desirable.
